## COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH TO CARE

The Nevada Qualifying House is a licensed Group Foster Home designed to provide therapeutic services, education support, life skills training, and recreational activities for male youth between the ages of 8 and 17.

Youth are separated by ages 8-13 and 14-17 in different houses for age-appropriate treatment and socialization. Our program utilizes a trauma-informed model and evidence-based practices to provide comprehensive care in a stable, therapeutic, homelike environment, with round-the-clock support from house parents and attentive staff.



## WHO WE SERVE

We specialize in serving youth who are transitioning from residential care to a community-based setting and youth who are in a family foster home setting and need more support and services. Our program is appropriate for who have scored a level 4 or below on the Child and Adolescent Service Intensity Instrument (CASII) and present with behavioral, emotional, and psychological disturbances, complex trauma, and issues that include: family dysfunction, grief and loss, depression, impulse control issues.

## PROGRAM FEATURES

- Trauma-responsive services embedded within all aspects of service delivery
- Normalized environment that fosters physical, psychological, and emotional safety
- Youth attend community schools in Douglas County
- PATH certified equine therapy (Nevada Equine Assisted Therapy or Kids and Horses)
- Behavioral health services with licensed clinicians
- Personal skills development
- Individual, group, and family counseling
- Numerous opportunities to participate in extracurricular activities, community sports and clubs, community pool and libraries
